
Stats and Observations

- 71 Reported sightings (last year 74) 2 outside of the area reported to FOE and not counted; many outside the duration. All captured for future analysis.
- 59 Photos and 5 videos received
- 9 mum and bub pairs reported (6-7 different pairs) 11 pairs last year
- 59 separate observers (last year 57)
- Due to the increase in observations can only give a range from 30-45 individual koalas again, However this year we can distinguish 26 individuals based on timing and location.
- One injured koalas observed; injured front paw (mum with bub)
- Like last year males appeared to be 'chasing' females including those with joeys




This year WiSP conducted a short duration count in the Reserve. Two koala (1 male 1 female) were observed near the Henderson Homestead. Four koalas were observed on the manna gum plantation side of the reserve (mum and bub, male and female). Will continue this format.
