Another worthy cause which is well worth supporting is the Waratah Beach Life Saving Club here in Sandy Point. Once again The Life Saving Club is manned entirely by volunteers who not only provide Lifesaving Patrols all through summer but also run a very popular Nippers Programme which teaches our children all about being safe in the water.

The Life Saving Club is holding a Raising the Flags event on Sunday 27th November to celebrate the start of Summer. This will begin at 10am and conclude around 1pm with a free Sausage Sizzle. Some of the things happening on that day will be a chance to try out for Nippers, Clubhouse tours, and a Marine Rescue Waratah Display. Also they will be launching their Community CPR Programme which will include a demonstration on how to use a defibrillator. The intention of this programme is to hold CPR courses to train people in how to save lives, which is, in itself, a very worthy cause.
